This award recognizes a NYSAND Student or Active Member, credentialed within the past 3 years, that has consistently participated in district or state level activities.

The winner will have an expense paid trip (per NYSAND policies) to NYSAND's Annual Meeting and Exposition, as well as the Coordinating Cabinet and Board of Directors meetings that precede NYSAND's Annual Meeting and Exposition.

The completed application must be submitted on the Awards Page of the NYSAND website by 11:59pm EST February 1. No late entries will be accepted. District or self-nominations are acceptable.

This award will only be given in a year when there is an outstanding candidate as defined by being awarded 75 points or more. The NYSAND Awards Committee will determine eligibility and a winner.

If determined a winner, the winner will provide a summary of their experience for the NYSAND Newsletter, highlighting the benefits of attending the NYSAND Annual Meeting & Exposition.
